

HAMSTER MIX

Feeding Directions

Hamsters are omnivorous, which means they eat both vegetables and meat. Either feed the hamster at the same time each day or leave a constant food supply. Hamsters will not overeat but will often store food in their cheek pouches and put it in a hiding place to eat later. Remove food that is no longer fresh each day, and clean out the "hidden" food once a week. Provide fresh, clean water at all times.
